Powerful work in Nabitac

Essential Energy crews will complete major upgrade works in Nabitac this month to ensure a more robust electricity network for customers.

Regional manager North Coast, Brendon Neyland, said the project is part of Essential Energy's ongoing commitment to providing a reliable, safe and sustainable supply of power.

"Crews installed new power poles for a regulator site opposite 22 Clarkson Street in Nabitac during December.

"The final work will involve the installation of the regulator cans which will ensure more consistent voltage levels throughout the area it supplies, providing a stable electricity supply," Brendon said.

To allow crews to safely complete the work a power supply interruption will be necessary in parts of Nabitac, Dyers Crossing, Firefly, Glenora, Wang Wauk, Bunyah, Minimbah and surrounding areas - affected customers will be notified in advance.

"We thank customers for their understanding while this important improvement work is carried out," Brendon said.
